

Rhyme Squad Dress Day Rules

Example: Cat and Hat

How It Works:

- Form a squad with at least one other person. Together, you must take two words that rhyme and then dress like those two words. (Example: Cat and Hat.)
- Duplicates are not allowed. For example: 1 cat and 5 hats. You may have 1 cat and 1 hat.
- To earn points, you must present a photo of you and your squad to your homeroom teacher during homeroom.

What's OK:

- Shorts must be at least mid-thigh, similar to the length of the students' uniform shorts.
- Skirts must be no more than 3 inches above the knee. (Longer is better!)
- Keep clothing and accessories modest.
- Tank tops are permitted but must not reveal any undergarments. If wearing a tank top, a jacket or another sleeve top must be worn.
- Pants are allowed, but no ripped jeans.

- Inappropriate or suggestive rhymes
- Midriff and crop tops
- Tights and spandex

White Out Dress Day

What to Wear:

- As much as possible, wear plain white shirts.
- Shirts with sleeves and a neck are highly recommended to maximize your "glow."
- Shorts must be at least mid-thigh, similar to the length of the students' uniform shorts. Any color is permitted (a neon color is highly recommended to maximize your "glow").
- Pants are allowed, but no ripped jeans

- Undergarments that are visible/see-through.
- Midriff and crop tops
- Any designs, logos, pictures and/or words that are offensive
- Tights and spandex

Pepper Squad Dress Day

What to Wear:

- Dress like your mascot or something that represents the fast food chain's brand (i.e. Burger King crown)
- Alternative: Wear your class t-shirt with denim long pants

- Midriff and crop tops
- Any designs, logos, pictures and/or words that are offensive
- Articles of clothing that reveal undergarments
- Tights and spandex
- Slippers and/or crocs

Black, White and Gold Day

Friday, January 13



What to Wear:

- Show your school pride and wear black, white and gold!
- Appropriate accessories/props allowed (i.e. colored headbands, bandanas, etc.)
- Shorts must be at least mid-thigh, similar to the length of the students' uniform shorts.
- Denim bottoms are allowed.

- Midriffs and crop tops
- Basketball and Board Shorts
- Tank tops that show cleavage or undergarments
- No tights or spandex
- Crocs and slippers
